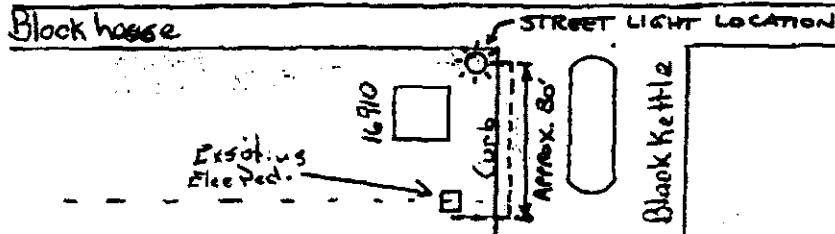

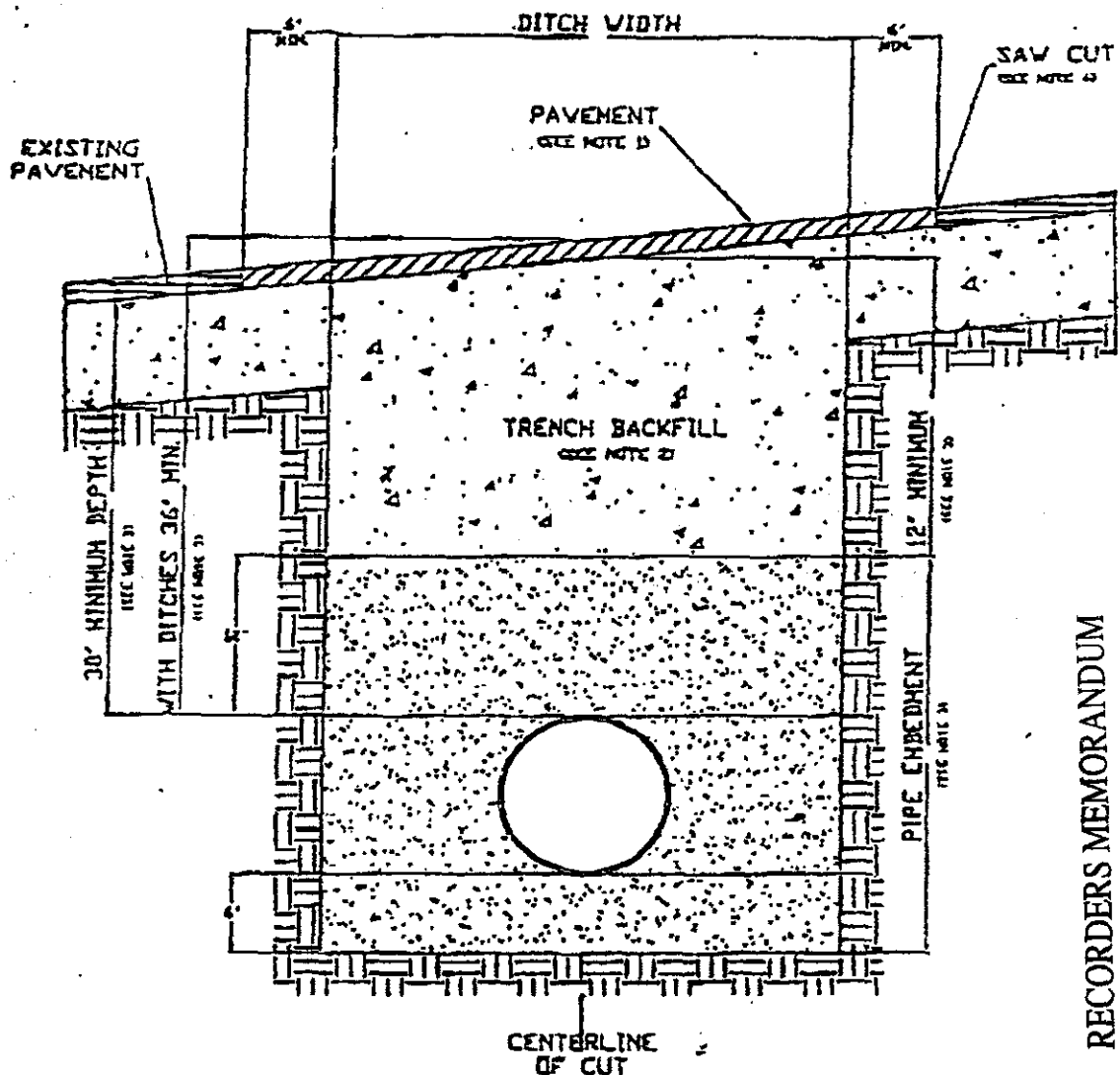

PERPENDICULAR UTILITY CUT DESIGN IN WILLIAMSON COUNTY R.O.W.

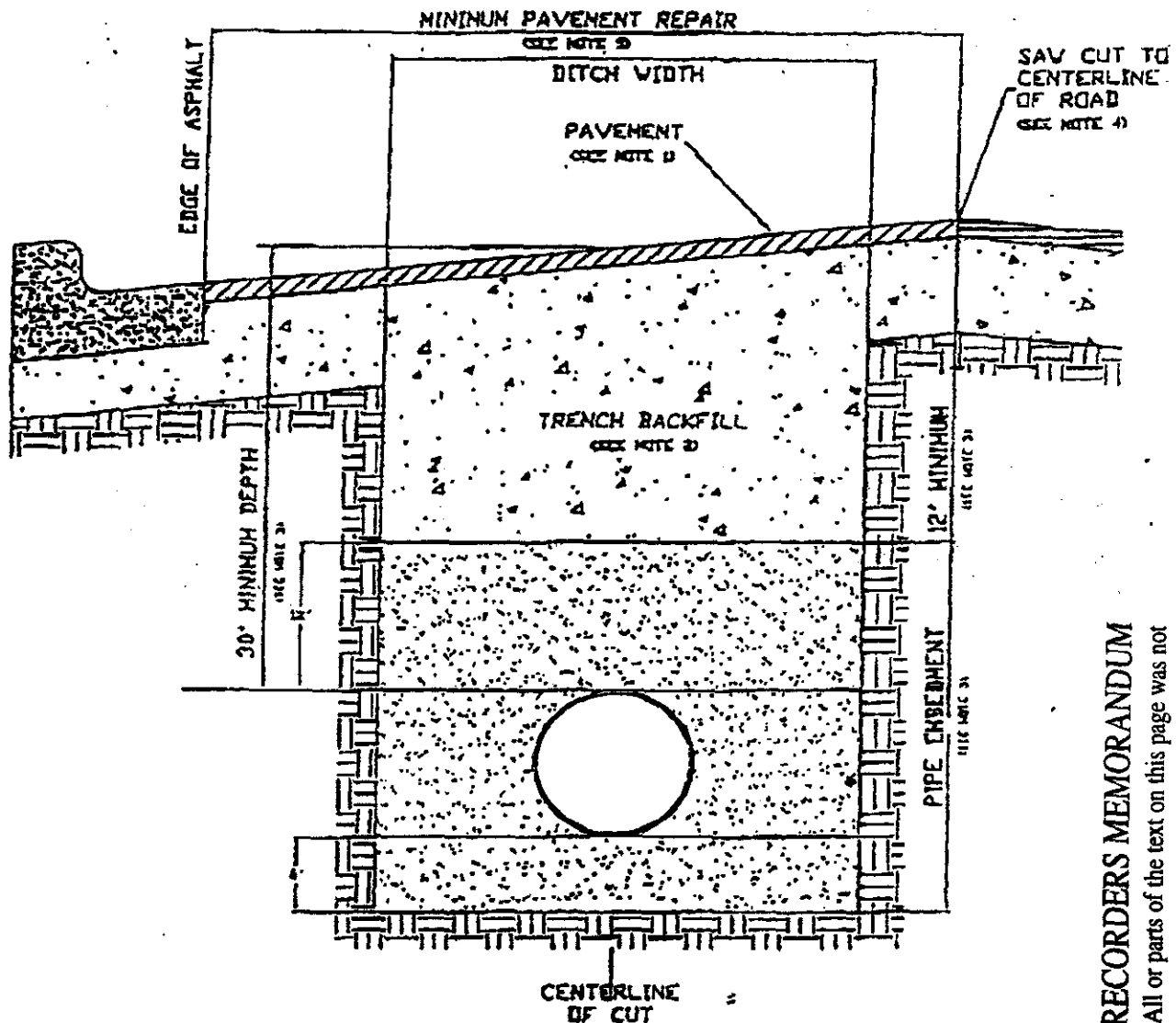

1. Hot mix asphalt 1 1/2" min. thickness. Roll in place to match existing surface, + or - 1/8" tolerance.
2. Trench backfill shall be flexible base, compacted to 95% optimum in 6" layers unless otherwise approved and specified. Flexible base to match existing base thickness or 8 inches, whichever is greater (specifications; TxDOT Item 247, Type A, Grade 2).

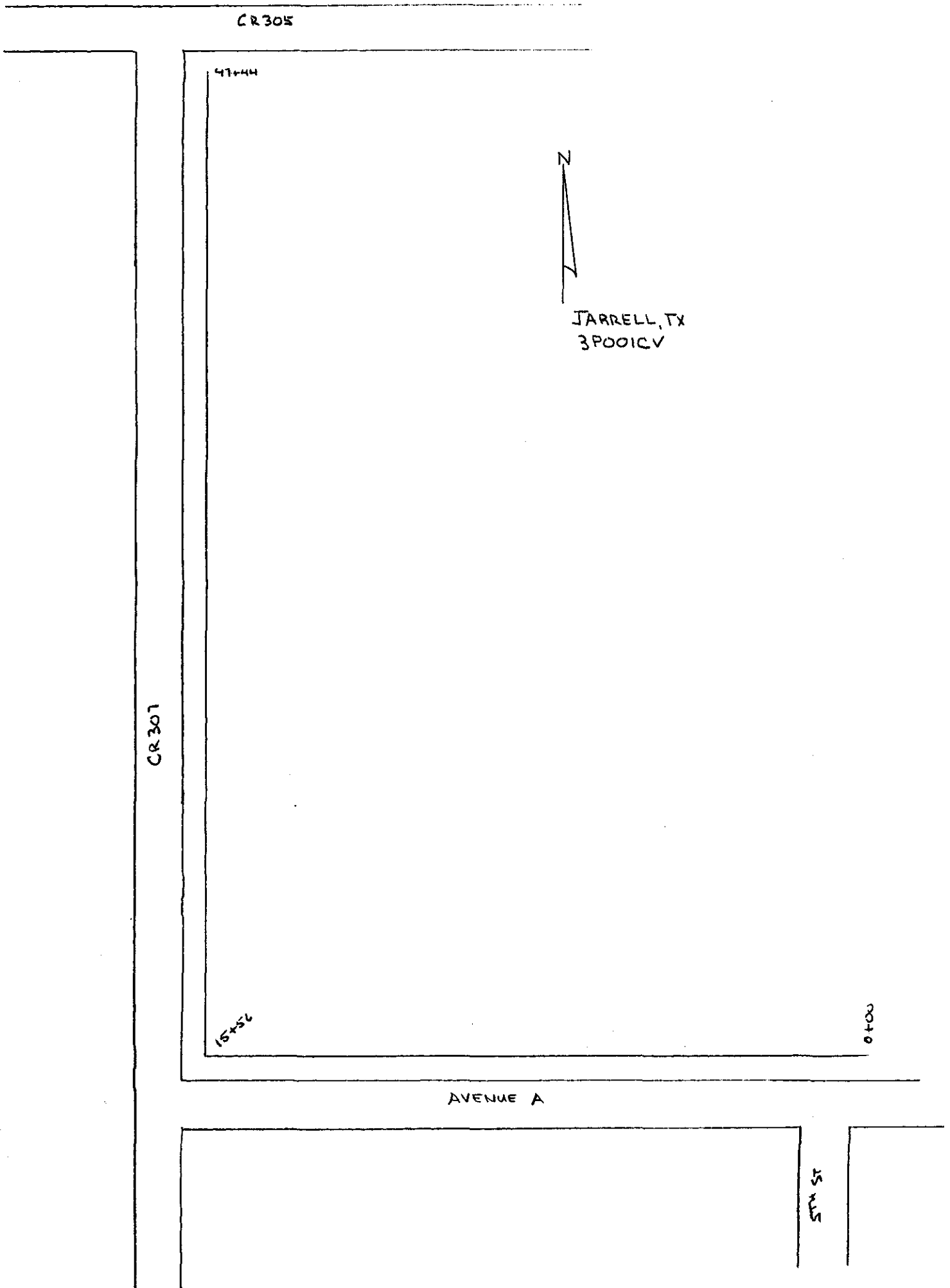

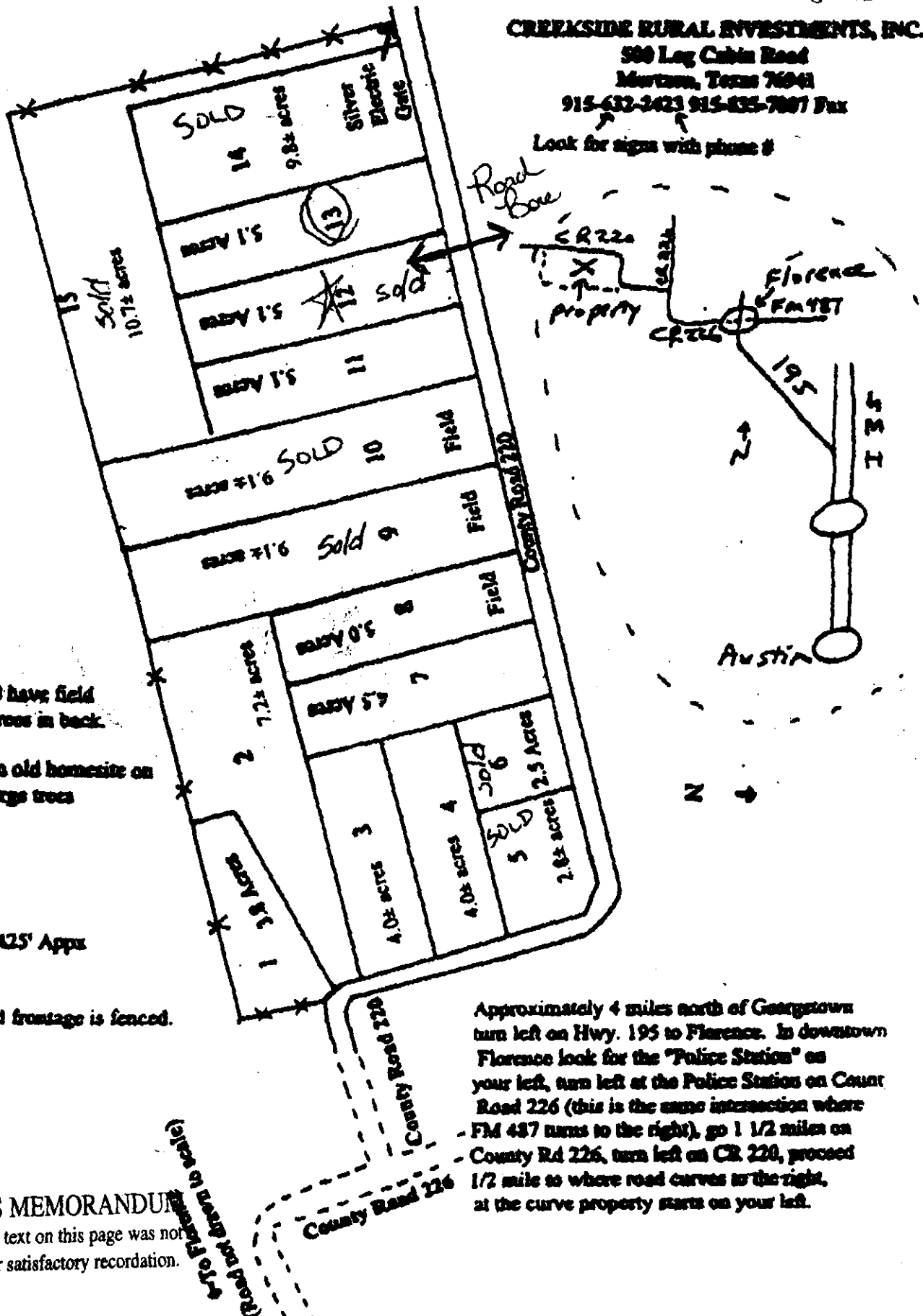
