On this the 27th day of August, 2002, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, does hereby order the following action, effective October 19, 2002:


(1) that the new polling place for precinct 152 be the Palm Springs Baptist Church, 13461 Pond Springs Road, Austin. The former polling place, Round Rock Opportunity Center, 13401 Pond Springs Road, was closed.

(2) that the new polling location for precinct 244 be the Liberty Hill Middle School, 101 Loop 332, Liberty Hill. The former polling place, the Terlip Residence at 102 Blue Quail Drive, Middle Gabriel Estates, was too small for some elections.

(3) that the new polling place for precinct 254 be the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, 77700 W. Whitestone Blvd., Cedar Park, Texas. The former polling place, Cedar Park City Hall, 600 N. Bell, no longer has space available because of remodeling.

4) that the new polling place for precinct 426 be Hutto High School, 101 FM 685, Hutto, Texas. The former polling place, Norman's Crossing Community Building, 12060 FM 1660, has been difficult to reserve on occasion.

(5) that a new branch early voting location be the Williamson County Annex, 350 Discovery Boulevard, Cedar Park, Texas. The former early voting location, Cedar Park City Hall, 600 N. Bell, no longer has space available for voting.


