


**AGENDA ITEM 45****Comments from commissioners.**

**Commissioner Boatright** discussed the Williamson County Regional Park progress, and stated that the water well that was acidized recently is producing 48 gallons per minute. He said he hopes to have a Parks Director to introduce to the Parks Advisory Committee on September 28, 2002.

**Commissioner Hays** asked about when the pay increase for employees will take effect. Judge Doerfler stated that, since the budget year starts in the middle of a pay period, the increase will not take effect until October 11, but will carry over into the next year's budget, to make a full 26 pay periods.
