

In connection with the issuance earlier this year of \$6,425,000 Avery Ranch Road District #1 Unlimited Tax Road Bonds, Series 2002, we recommend the adoption of a \$0.275/\$100 tax levy by the Avery Ranch Road District #1. This levy is the same as that anticipated to be needed to service the debt for the referenced Bonds when they were issued in February, 2002. Collection of this levy will supplement capitalized interest currently being invested by the County for purposes of paying debt service on the Bonds scheduled to become payable during fiscal 2003. AN ORDER LEVYING TAXES PROVIDING FOR THE INTEREST  
AND SINKING FUND FOR THE YEAR 2002.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AVERY RANCH

## I.

That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the Avery Ranch Road District No. 1 to provide for Interest and Sinking Funds for the year 2002 upon all property, real, personal and mixed, within the boundaries of said District subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.275 cents on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property.

## II.

All monies collected under this Order be and the same are hereby appropriated and set apart for the specific purpose indicated herein and that the Williamson County Assessor and Collector of shall keep these accounts so as to readily and distinctly show the amount collected, the amounts expended and the amount on hand at any time, belonging to such funds.

The District hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Order was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the


