**ORDER OF GENERAL ELECTION**

An election is hereby ordered to be held on November 5, 2002, in Williamson County, Texas for the purpose of electing the following county and precinct officers as required by Article XVI, Section 65 of the Texas Constitution:

Main, Round Rock; Williamson County Taylor Annex, 412 Vance; Lakeline Mall at Mervyn's Court, 11200 Lakeline Mall, Cedar Park; Williamson County Cedar Park Annex, 350 Discovery Blvd; Brookshire Brothers, 3010 Williams Drive, Georgetown; Round Rock ISD Administration Building, 1311 Round Rock Avenue; Clay-Madsen Recreation Center, 1600 Gattis School Road, Round Rock; Brushy Creek MUD Office, 901 Great Oaks Drive, Round Rock.
