AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRONIC KEYBOARD AND SPINET PIANO

Friends of the Georgetown Symphony Society (FOGSS) wishes to give and Williamson County Juvenile Services (WCJS) wishes to receive the following instruments (pianos):

Roland RD 100 full-size electronic keyboard with Two Roland Speakers and sustain pedal, including all connections; an "X" stand, adjustable bench, music rest, cloth dust cover and user's manual;

and Everett spinet piano.

The parties agree as follows:

1. The pianos will be continuously housed at the Williamson County Juvenile Justice Center and will remain under the responsibility of the Williamson County Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP) Principal. The pianos will not be moved to any other school in Williamson County.
2. The pianos will be used not only for classes designed by the principal but for performances and recreational use as supervised by educational staff and other such purposes as determined by the JJAEP Principal.
3. After receipt of the pianos and initial setup and tuning of the spinet, the future tuning, maintenance and repair of the pianos will be the responsibility of Williamson County Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program.
4. FOGSS will have no responsibility for the pianos after they have been received by Williamson County Juvenile Justice Center and initial setup and tuning have been completed.
