


**Commissioner Boatright** thanked Dale Rye for his help on parks issues.

He is very concerned, and wants deliberation, comments and direction for the planning of next year's budget. Last week Workmen's Compensation went up from \$315,000 to \$965,000. What he initially is proposing to consider is the possibility of no salary increases, no reclassifications, and no new employees except those that can present a case in which the internal auditors' report recommends that their manpower is too low to accomplish the job as it should be done.
