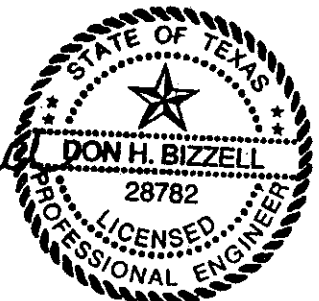
I would therefore recommend that this contract be awarded to Chasco Constructors LTD, L.L.P. in the amount of \$2,977,703.33

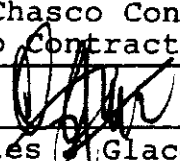
