Mutual Aid Agreement

The following is a Mutual Aid Agreement between:

Williamson County EMS and the City of Burnet EMS, herein referred to as Burnet EMS

The above organizations will provide emergency medical care upon request in accordance with the following:

1. The written Standing Orders of the respective Medical Director(s); and,
2. The certification level of each responding emergency vehicle and the certification levels of the responding personnel; and,
3. Any applicable regulations as outlined by the Texas Department of Health.

It is agreed that a response to a call for Mutual Aid is contingent on the ability of the responding organization's ability to fulfill any prior commitments to provide emergency care and the availability of personnel.

It is also agreed that this agreement may be terminated at any time by written notice.
