Jo Ann Ford addressed the court regarding a request for funds for the Georgetown Community Clinic.

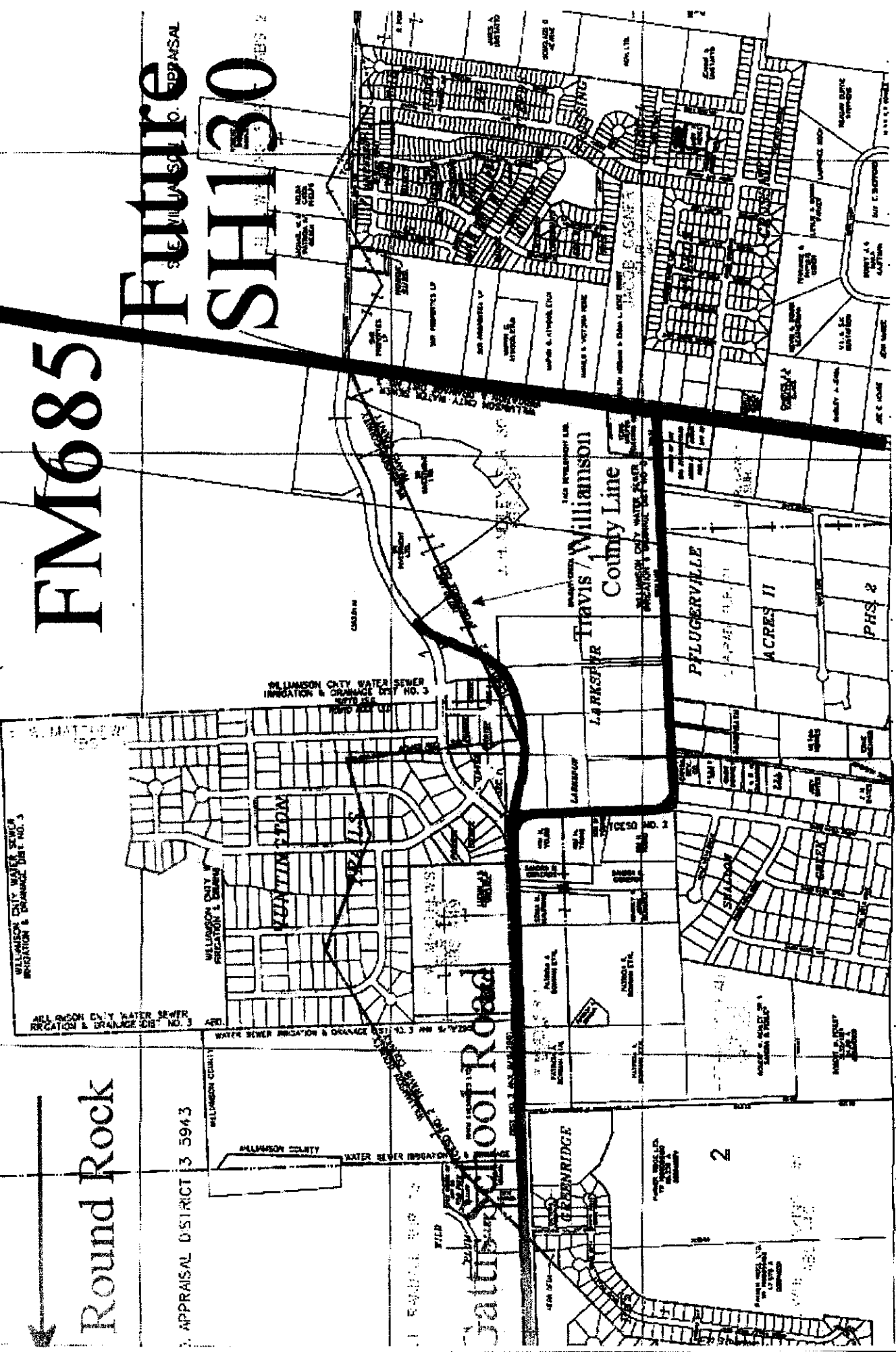

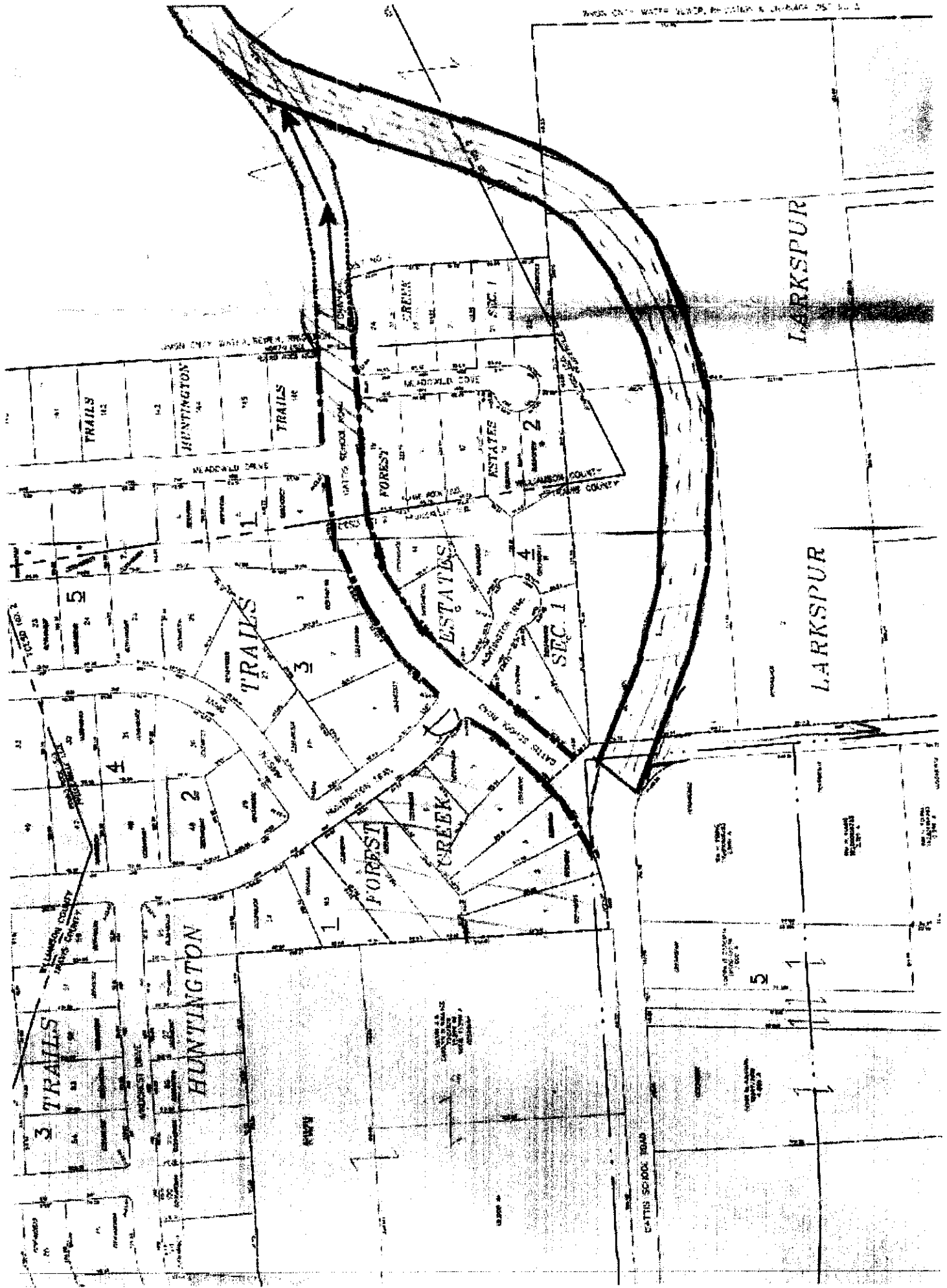
