Would you please add the following to the Commissioner's Court Agenda?

Consider authorizing the County Judge to sign an agreement with Intrado for the 911 Emergency Data from the Williamson County area.

Intrado is the State's vendor for the collection of 911 phone data. We are allowed to have this information through the agreement already signed with CAPCO. This information allows our Reverse 911 system to call all the phones in our County.

The cost to download the new information quarterly will be about \$7,600 annually. However Intrado has offered to let the City of Round Rock and us split the cost for this service. Keith Tanner will be consulting with the City to make sure they will agree to this offer.

I will be out of town next week at a WMD drill in Lubbock. Emily Stluka has agreed to answer any questions the Court may have on this issue. She is very familiar with Intrado due to her 911 CAPCO Task Force involvement.
