**WHEREAS:** The problems of lawsuit abuse touch and effect all segments of our society, undermining and eroding the moral and economic strength of our communities and their citizens.


**NOW THEREFORE,** the Williamson County Commissioner's Court does hereby proclaim the week of September 30, through October 4, 2003 as:


**Lawsuit Abuse Awareness Week**
