**AGENDA ITEM 20**

Hear presentation from Martha Juch on the recommendation from the Brushy Creek Trailhead Property Uses Committee.

Martha Juch addressed the court as the Chair of the Brushy Creek Trailhead Property Uses Committee regarding the Brushy Creek Trailhead property. Ms. Juch presented the four uses recommended by the committee as: 1) trail connection with pavilions, 2) multi-age "playscape" area, 3) outdoor nature classroom, and 4) a hillside theatre with natural seating area which would accommodate fewer than 500 persons.

Lisa Birkman, Julie Bassett, Ken Vogelmann and Joan Brown all spoke with disapproval on the hillside theatre concept, as it would be in direct opposition to an anti-amphitheatre petition which was signed by 1400 area residents.

**Commissioner Heiligenstein** expressed his belief that the land should benefit the county at-large, as it was purchased for \$20,000.00 per acre with County funds, or it should be sold to bring in funds for the regional park.
