National Public Safety Telecommunications Week April 11-17, 2004

WHEREAS, the safety of our peace officers, firefighters, and paramedics is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone the Williamson County E-911 Communications Center;

WHEREAS, Public Safety Dispatchers are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services;

WHEREAS, Public Safety Dispatchers are the single vital link for our peace officers, firefighters, and paramedics by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information, and ensuring their safety;


WHEREAS, Public Safety Dispatchers of the Williamson County E-911 Communications Center have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients;


WHEREAS, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of his or her job in the past year;
