WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 1

CHANDLER ROAD, PHASE IIIA (FM 1660 TO CR 368)


This Work Authorization is made pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement entered into by and between Williamson County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, (*the "County"*) and S.D. Kallman, L.P. ~ Engineers and Environmental Consultants (*the "Engineer"*).

Part 1. The *Engineer* will provide the following engineering services:

1. Meet with Cobb, Fendley and Associates, Inc., Coordinator (CFA) and Williamson County Staff to determine Scope of Project and Relocation Efforts.
2. Identify and determine precise locations of all existing utility structures adjacent to or within existing or proposed ROW of project limits; conduct utility office research; and obtain as-builts from utility owner(s).
3. Surveying required to locate, mark and tie all existing utilities into project survey including horizontal and vertical locations, and below ground elevation information if applicable. Consult with Coordinator (CFA) and Williamson County Engineer to determine the need and applicability for Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) methods.
4. *S.D. KALLMAN, L.P.* and Cobb, Fendley and Associates, Inc. (Coordinator) shall monitor utility relocation plan preparation by utility owner(s) and relocation efforts to ensure conflicts are eliminated prior to letting.

Part 2. The maximum amount payable for services under this Work Authorization without modification is \$50,450.00.

Part 3. Payment to the *Engineer* for the services established under this Work Authorization shall be made in accordance with the Agreement.

Part 4. This Work Authorization shall become effective on the date of final acceptance of the parties hereto and shall terminate on May 1, 2006, unless extended by a Supplemental Work Authorization. 

Part 5. This Work Authorization does not waive the parties' responsibilities and obligations provided under the Agreement.


