WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate for those who experience sudden illness or injury; and


WHEREAS, Williamson County EMS personnel also care for the community by teaching injury prevention to citizens to lessen the occurrence and severity of injuries; and
