**ORDER DESIGNATING CHANGES IN EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS**

On this the 6<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2004, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, does hereby order the following changes in early voting locations, effective February 23, 2004:

1. Designate Sun City Social Center, 2 Texas Drive, Georgetown, TX, as a full-time location.
2. Designate the Celebrations Store, 3010 Williams Drive, as a full-time location, using the same building formerly occupied by Brookshire Brothers.
3. Designate the new Brushy Creek MUD office, 16318 Great Oaks Drive, as a temporary location for Commissioner Precinct 1, with voting hours to be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, February 28; Noon to 5 p.m., Sunday, February 29; and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. March 1-5, 2004.
