ORDER DESIGNATING CHANGES IN EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

On this the 6th day of January, 2004, the Commissioners' Court of Williamson County, Texas, does hereby order the following changes in early voting locations, effective February 23, 2004:

1. Designate Sun City Social Center, 2 Texas Drive, Georgetown, TX, as a full-time location.
2. Designate the Celebrations Store, 3010 Williams Drive, as a full-time location, using the same building formerly occupied by Brookshire Brothers.
3. Designate the new Brushy Creek MUD office, 16318 Great Oaks Drive, as a temporary location for Commissioner Precinct 1, with voting hours to be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, February 28; Noon to 5 p.m., Sunday, February 29; and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. March 1-5, 2004.
