John Sneed, from E.M.S., addressed the Court regarding Medic 34, which is an ambulance of advanced years.

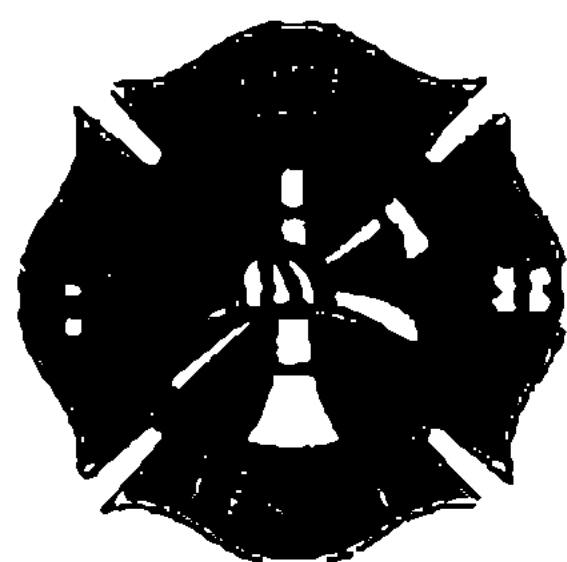
