Discuss and take appropriate action on request for District Attorney to hire 2 additional staff members, 1 prosecutor and 1 support personnel, effective July for direct filing of cases.

District Attorney John Bradley addressed the Court regarding his need to hire two additional staff members to implement direct filing of cases. Answering a question posed by **Judge Doerfler**, he stated that in the next fiscal year, his office will ask for two new prosecutors, one new investigator, and one new legal secretary in addition to the request made today. **County Attorney Gene Taylor** also addressed the Court from the podium, addressing the issue of personal recognizance bonds (PR Bonds) and calling for a rule that police officers must file their reports the day they make the arrest, which would be sooner than the present rule requires.
