**Williamson County Justice Center  
Parking Garage Policy  
May 25, 2004**

1. The parking garage will be open to the public weekdays from 5:30 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. and from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 a.m. on the weekends and holidays. At all other times the parking garage will be reserved for Williamson County employees and visitors to the Justice Center and Sheriff's Department.
2. Williamson County reserves the right to close the parking garage at any time for special County events.
3. Williamson County will post the following signs at the parking garage
  - a. "Park at your own risk"
  - b. "Parking garage reserved for Williamson County employees and visitors to the Justice Center and Sheriff's Department during business hours.  
Public parking weekdays from 5:30 p.m. until 1:00 a.m.  
and weekends from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 a.m.  
Violators will be towed at all other times"
  - c. No loitering
4. The Williamson County Commissioners Court reserves the right to review and revise this policy at any time.
